6 MONTHS EXTENSION FOR EXISTING TELEVISION BROADCAST LICENSE

2nd July, 2012, Suva, Fiji Islands – Fiji Television Limited's existing television broadcast license was extended by the Minister of Communications, Mr Aiyaz Sayed Khaiyum for a further 6 month period with effect from 30th June, 2012.



In his letter of 29th June, 2012 to Fiji TV, the Minister stated that the extension will be "*until further notice of any additional terms and conditions, including spectrum allocation, that may be prescribed, FTL shall continue to broadcast under the terms and conditions contained in the existing license for the extended period*".



Fiji Television Limited is the South Pacific's largest broadcaster in this Region, excluding Australia and New Zealand. It broadcasts its free to air station, Fiji One, via Sky Pacific to Fiji and 10 other Pacific Island countries. Through its direct to home satellite service, the company has 100% coverage throughout Fiji.



Fiji TV has a wholly owned subsidiary company in PNG. The company, Media Niugini Limited, operates as EMTV, is PNG's only free to air commercial station.



MNL, wholly owns a subsidiary company in the Solomon Islands, Media Solomon Island Limited. This subsidiary company has a television broadcast license and is expected to commence its television service soon.
